Rules & Conditions of Entry

GECAG's From Inspiration to Creation 2025

1. Artists must be 2025 financial members to enter.
2. Paintings/artwork must be the original work of the exhibitor that do not infringe on copyright laws.
3. Each adult exhibitor may enter a maximum of three paintings/or works. One entry only per child.
4. **LABEL:** Each exhibit must be clearly marked on the back with artist's name, title, medium, price, size, phone number and email address. For your convenience, labels are available at the Moorleigh Village studio. Pairs must be clearly marked. An entry can be marked 'not for sale'.
5. **ENTRANCE FEE AND ENTRY DUE DATE:**

Adults - \$10 for ONE artwork, \$15 for TWO, \$20 for THREE
Children - \$5.00 for each child's entry. Fees and entries are due by MONDAY 31st March 5pm.

Pay the entry fees and enter your artwork details via Trybooking:
<https://www.trybooking.com/eventlist/gecag> scroll and click on From Inspiration to Creation. The password is *Create2025* ! Only complete and send a hardcopy entry form if you don't have computer access. Leave it in GECAG's studio office in the Art Show Coordinator's tray along with your payment, or post your entry form along with your payment to Room 81, Bob Flavell Wing, Moorleigh Community Village, 92 Bignell Road, East Bentleigh, 3165 by Monday 31st March 5pm.
6. **DELIVERY:** Entries are to be delivered to the Glen Eira Council Gallery, on the corner of Glen Eira and Hawthorn Roads, Caulfield. Parking is available behind the building. Enter the building via the Portico entrance on the Glen Eira Road side of the building.
The delivery date is on Monday 7th April from 12 noon to 2pm.
Please note: deliveries shall not be accepted any earlier than 12noon on this date.
Call *Jenny Davrain 0425 761444* or *Jing Lin 0433 675236* should you need to make other arrangements.
7. **COLLECTION:** Entries must remain on display until 5pm Sunday 18th May and must be collected between 5.00pm and 6.00pm on Sunday 18th May. Please note only gallery staff are allowed to take down the works.
8. **COMMISSION:** The Gallery does not process sales. The person interested in purchasing will be able to leave a record of their 'expression of interest' in a book provided by GECAG on our table at the gallery. The sale is then wholly conducted between the buyer and artist. No commission is charged.
9. **ACCEPTANCE & DISPLAY:** The display of exhibits shall be at the sole discretion of the GECAG Exhibition Committee, who reserve the right to refuse any entry, as well as to refuse to display entries.
10. **FRAMING:** IMPORTANT – All framed artwork must be framed to a professional standard, fitted at the back with framing wire that has two centimeters of slack to allow for hanging. Due to the hanging technique of the Gallery **ALL FRAMES MUST BE FITTED WITH "D CLIPS"** preferably fixed 70mm below the top edge of the frame. Hanging cords made of anything other than secure wire are unacceptable.
11. **INSURANCE:** The Glen Eira City Council Gallery is not responsible for any loss or damage howsoever caused to any artwork or personal property. GECAG will exercise reasonable care in handling the works submitted, but will not be responsible for any loss or damage to artwork or personal property.
12. **ROSTER:** Exhibiting members are asked to serve on the roster to mind the exhibition. Members are responsible for staffing during opening hours. Select your time via Trybooking:
<https://www.trybooking.com/eventlist/gecag> scroll and click on From Inspiration to Creation Roster Duty. The password is *Create2025*. Book a time and go to Find More Events for second and subsequent time slots (we have many to fill).
13. **ALTERATIONS:** No entry forms, no alterations to titles or prices will be accepted after the entry closing date of *Monday 31st March 5pm*.
